Period ended 30 June 2025



Executive Summary

The number of live companies on the register stood at 36,015 at the end of the second quarter of 2025.

The net asset value of regulated funds under administration increased by £14.1bn from £451.8bn to £465.9bn during Q2 2025.

The total value of banking deposits held in Jersey increased from £165.3bn to £182.7bn during Q2 2025.

The number of banking licences stood at 19 at the end of Q2 2025.

The total number of regulated collective investment funds remained the same at 608 as at the end of Q2 2025.

The value of total funds under investment management stood at £36.1bn at the end of Q2 2025. These figures do not include the total assets under management within the qualifying segregated managed accounts (QSMA), which stood at £5.2bn at the end of the quarter.

The total number of investment managers for the second quarter of 2025 stood at 16,100 which is an increase of 294 on the first quarter of 2025 which was 15,806.

As at 30 June 2025 there were 754 JPFs registered and 105 GIMBs registered.

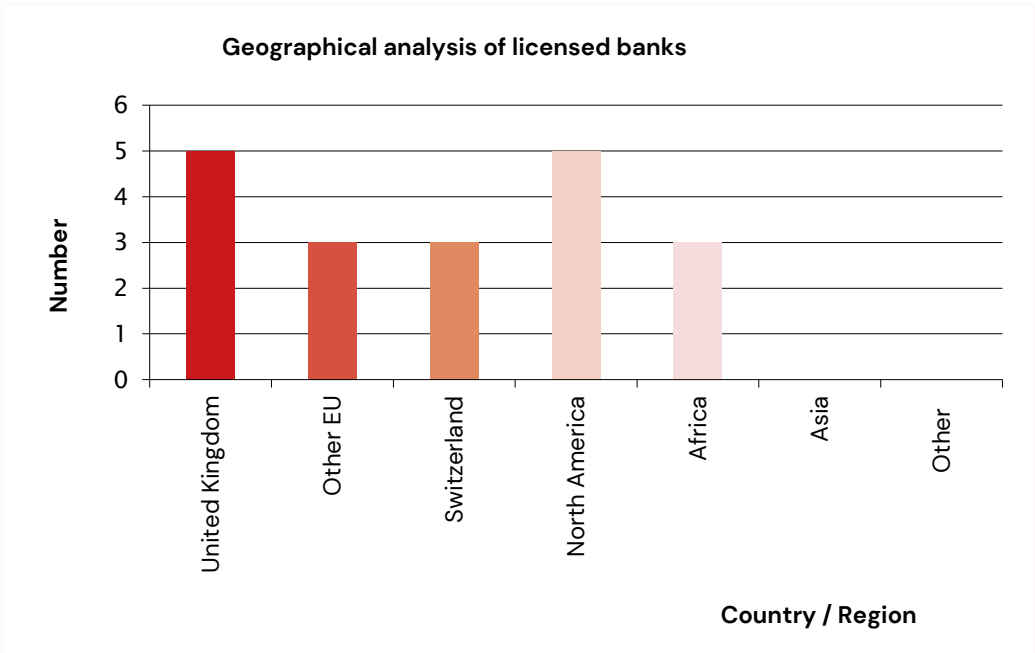
Banks

Registered banks

There were 19 banks registered in Jersey as at 30 June 2025.

The geographical analysis of registered banks (based on the jurisdiction of the ultimate parent company) is set out in figure 1.

Bank deposits

Total banking deposits held in Jersey increased during Q2 2025 from £165.3bn to £182.7bn

Figure 2 – Analysis of bank deposits as at 30 June 2025¹

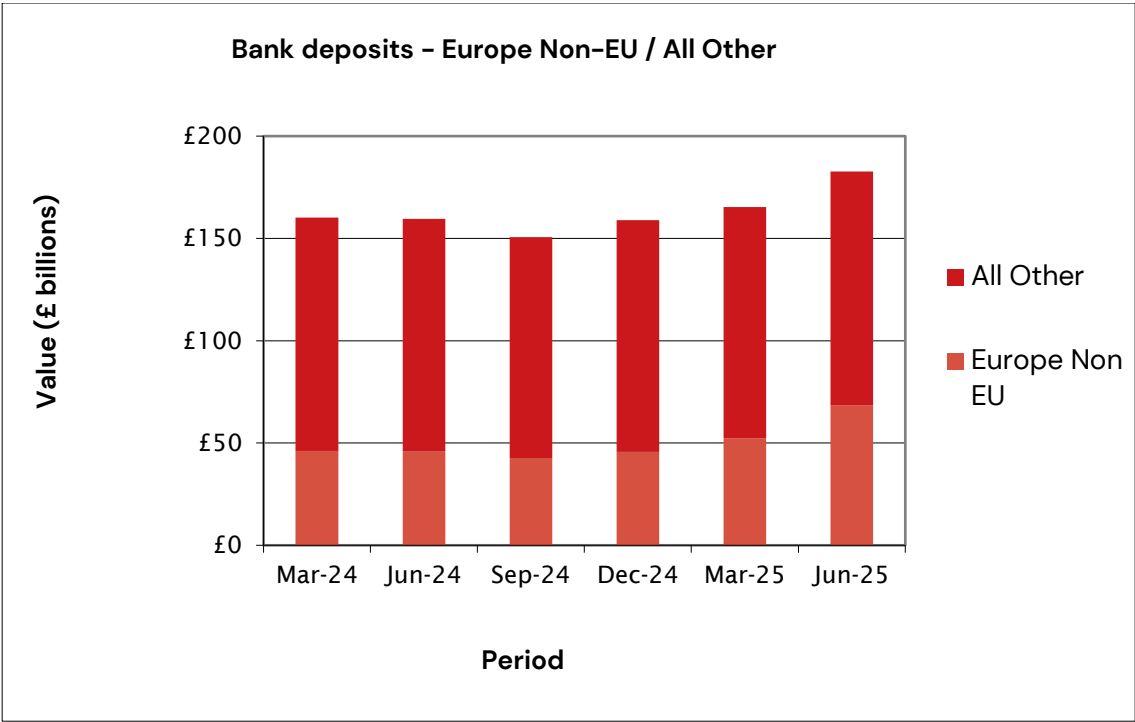
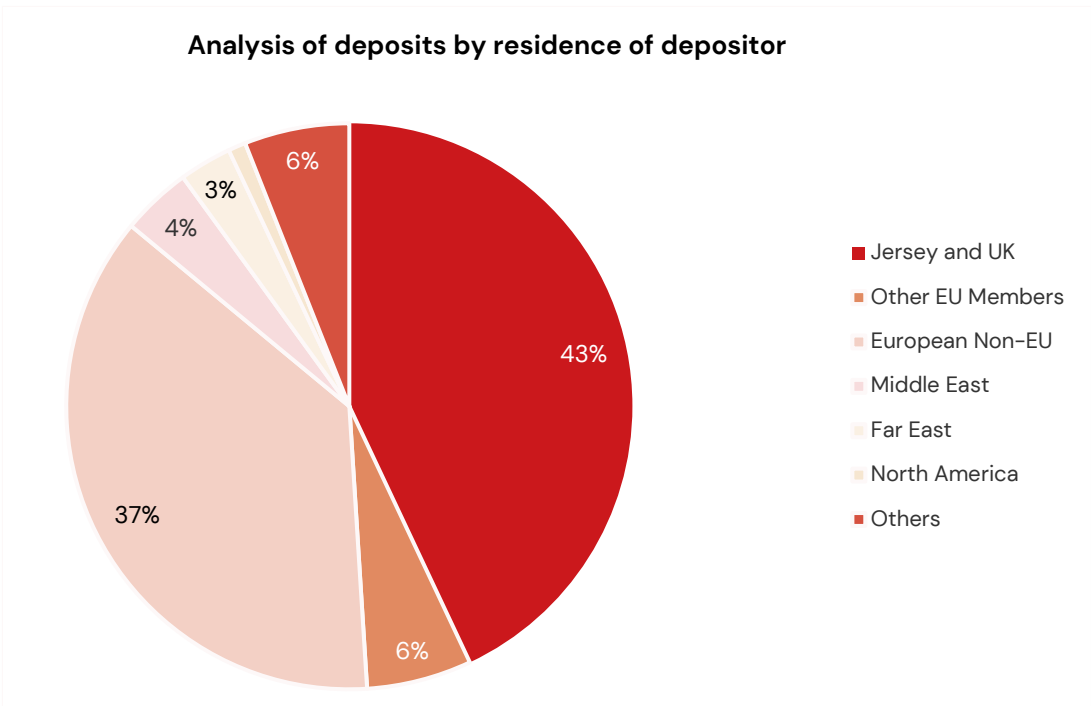


Figure 3 – Deposits by residence of depositors on 30 June 2025



¹ Deposits are analysed between deposits from 'European non-EU Members' and other deposits. The reason for this split is that 'European non-EU Members' includes a significant element of wholesale fiduciary deposits on which margins are much lower than on other types of deposits.

Funds and Fund Management

The following data includes both Jersey and non-Jersey domiciled funds administered in Jersey. However, excluded from the analyses are collective investment funds for which the only services provided in Jersey are distribution or similarly minor activities. These funds are regarded as non-Jersey funds for current statistical purposes.

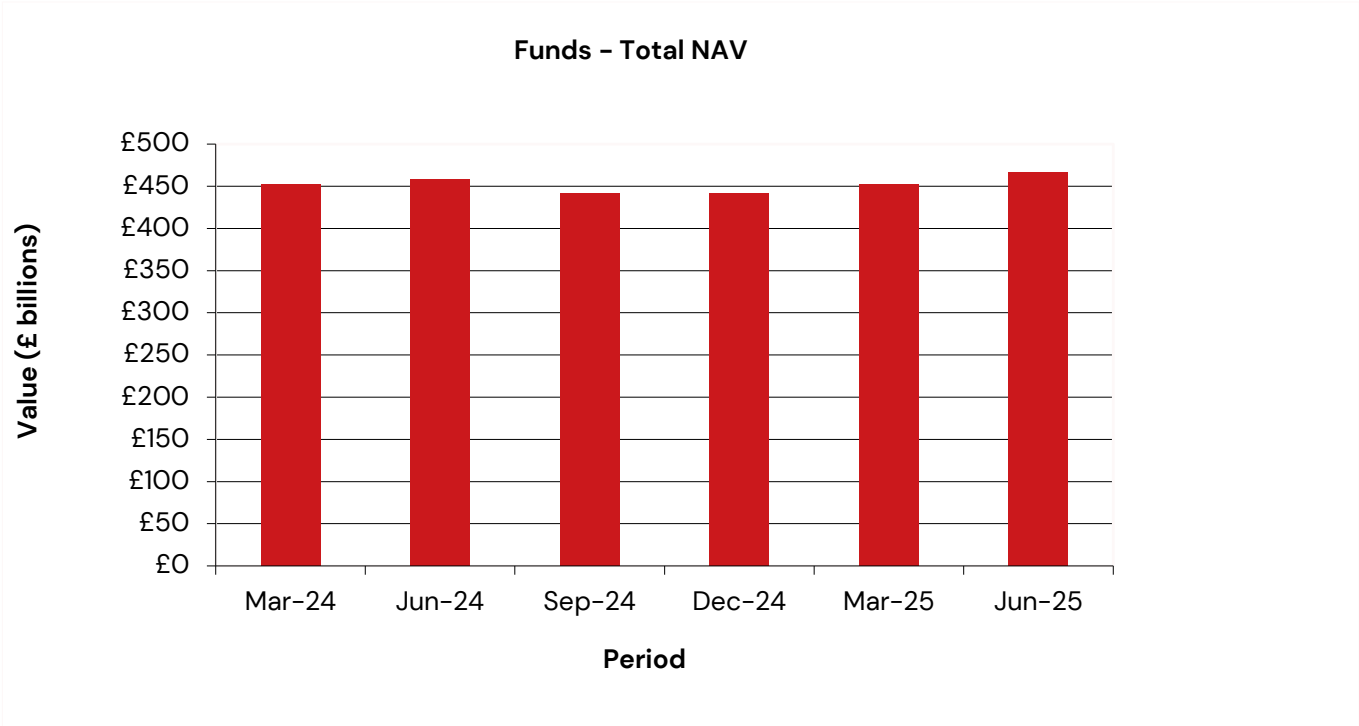
The data also includes funds established under the Control of Borrowing (Jersey) Order 1958 (COBO). COBO funds are private schemes with fewer than 55 offers which do not require a permit under CIF Law, but which do require an initial regulatory consent in the form of a consent granted under COBO.

Key statistics

During the second quarter of 2025, the net asset value of regulated funds under administration increased by £14.1bn from £451.8bn to £465.9bn.

The total number of regulated collective investment funds stayed the same at 608.

Figure 4 – Net asset value of regulated funds as at 30 June 2025



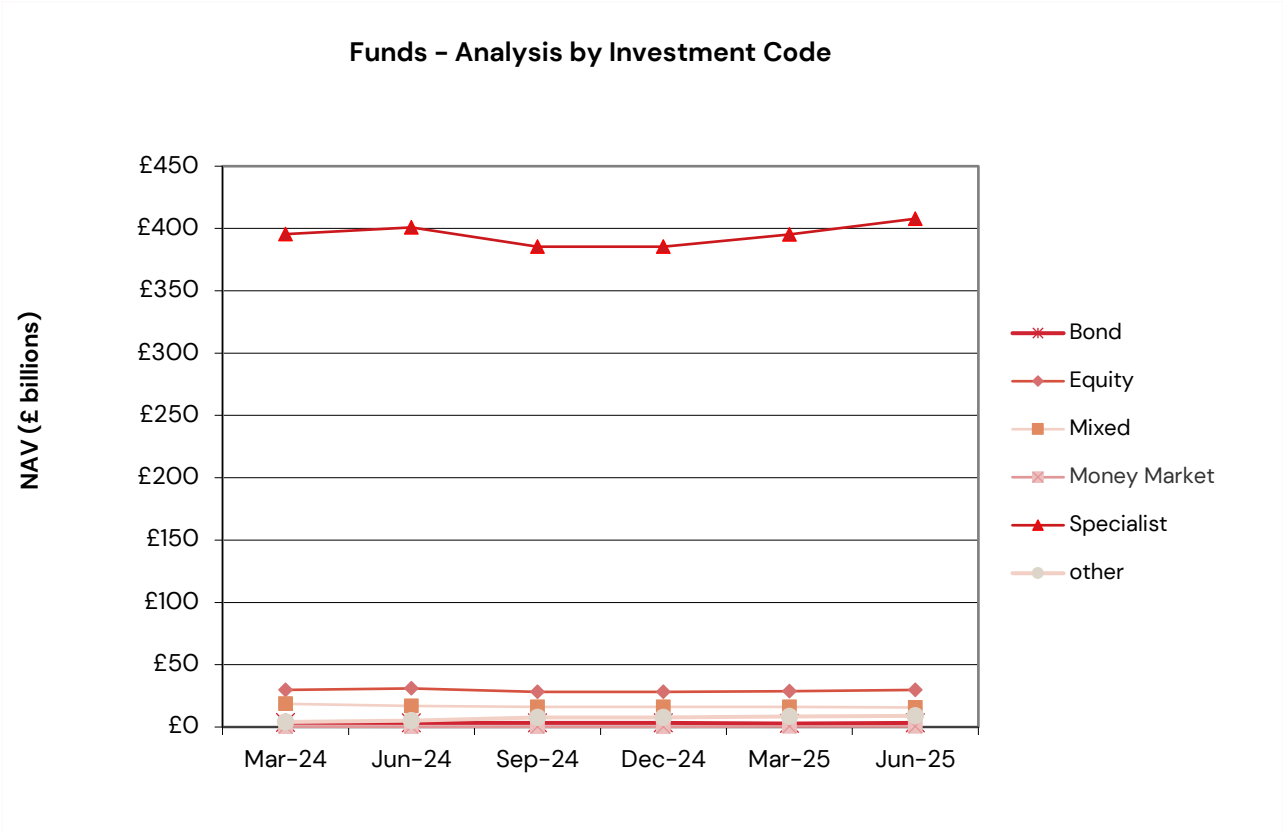
COBO Only Private Placement Funds

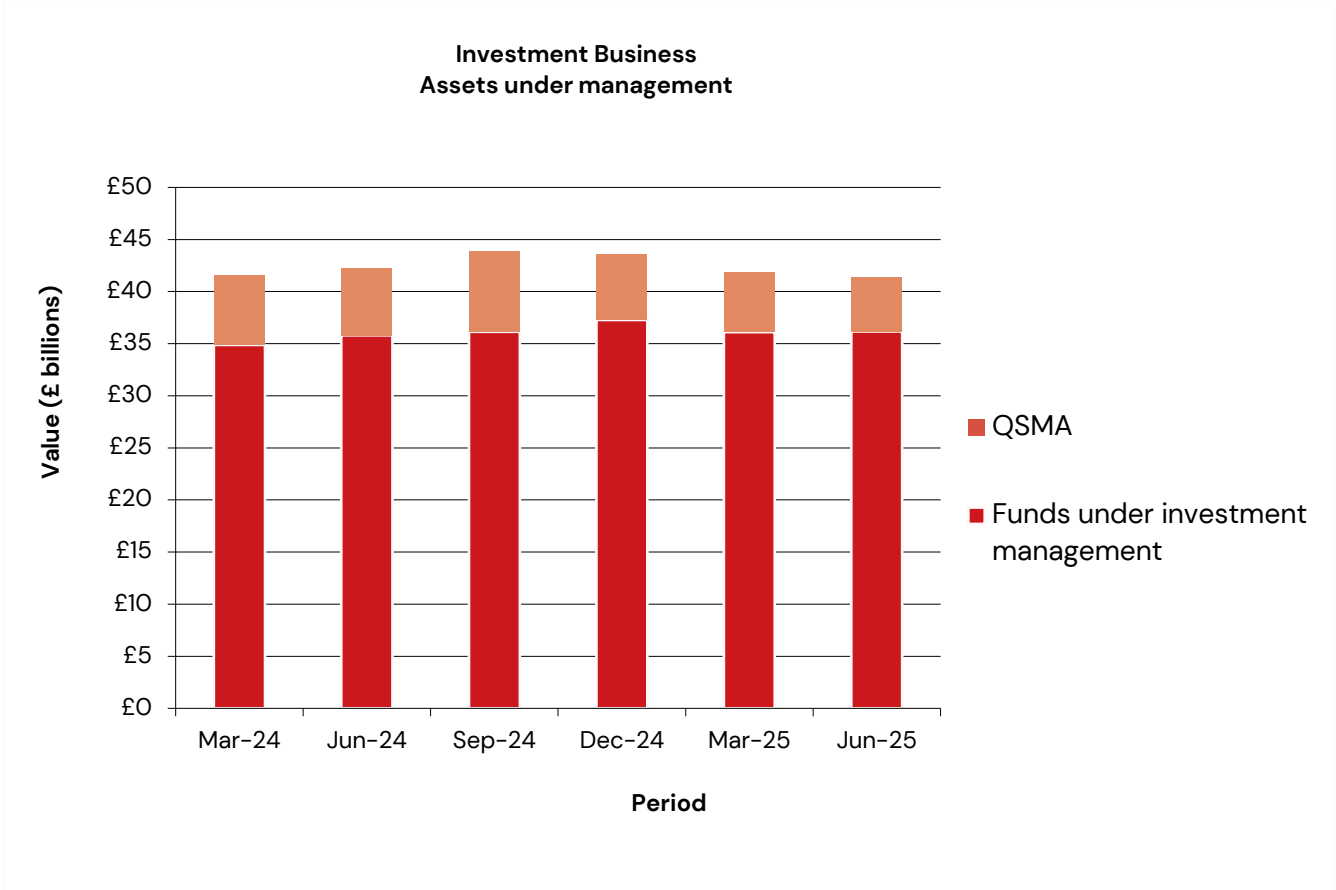
Figure 7 – Live companies on the register as at 30 June 2025
